Communication and Language
We will introduce oracy rules to the
children where they will begin to learn the
skills to become effective speakers as they
get older. There will be plenty of
opportunities to apply these skills when
talking to friends and teachers.

#### Maths

This half term we will begin by matching, sorting and comparing objects. They will then move on to exploring numbers up to 5. The children will be encouraged to count to 5 accurately, subitise, partition numbers to 5 into two parts and say one less or one more than a given number.

## Expressive Art & Design

We will learn how to use different resources and how to manipulate them in different ways to create their own master pieces. They will also explore using paints and mixing colours:

For the first half of the term, we will focus on traveling in different ways, such as running, hopping, jumping.
Following on from this, we will create shapes and movements in time to music,

# Understanding the World

### Literacy

In reading, we will begin our RWI phonics lessons. In writing, we will begin by practising correct formation of letters and then following on from this, we will begin to write simple CVC words, for example, mat, tin, etc. Some of us will have a go at writing sentences.
