

Communication and Language

We will be becoming more familiar with the oracy expectations and will be continuing to talk with our talk partners to share ideas and opinions about a topic. Children will have sentence stems that encourage them to talk in full sentences.

Physical Development

We will continue to develop our fine motor skills through scissor, tweezer and threading activities.

This half term, we will be focusing on dance in PE. The children will learn to move in different ways, exploring and remembering actions where they will consider level, shape and direction.

Understanding the World

This half term, we will be learning all about autumn and the changes that happen to the outside environment.

The children will be visiting Brookvale Park and will spend time completing some autumnal activities. We will also be learning about the Christmas story and why Christians celebrate Christmas.

We will be practising our Nativity throughout this half term and will be performing it to our parents.

Maths

This half term, we will be exploring circles, triangles and squares. We will be learning about the properties of these 2D shapes.

The children will also be consolidating numbers one to three and will be introduced to numbers four and five. They will recognise numbers to five and reason how many objects there are without having to count them.



Literacy

In reading, we will continue in our RWI groups which will challenge us at a level that is appropriate to our individual needs. We will segment words into individual phonemes and blend them to read the whole word. We will read set 1 and 2 red words by sight.

We will also read a variety of books where we will be ordering the events in the correct order and creating our own story maps. We will also be doing some role play to put ourselves into the position of the characters to understand their feelings.

Expressive Art & Design

We will be using autumnal objects to create nature pictures. We will also be using these natural objects in our art work to turn them into something else such as a hedgehog or an owl. Children will be refining the skills they have learnt in Autumn 1.

Personal, Social & Emotional Development

This half term, we will be developing our skills when solving conflicts in a more mature way. We will also be exploring the book, 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears' and we will be talking about whether Goldilocks was right to go into the house alone as well as stranger danger.
