

RE/PSHE

In RE, we will be learning about three key dispositions: 'Being Accountable and Living with Integrity', 'Being Courageous and Confident', 'Being Loyal and Steadfast'. We will share and discuss beliefs within multiple communities of faith.

Computing

As we become more confident with our iPads, we will embed the skills needed to use them effectively to enhance our learning. Speech selection, split screen and uploading our work to the Showbie platform are skills that we'll continue to perfect in this term.

Reading

Children will continue to take part in daily phonics lessons using Ruth Miskin's Read Write Inc (RWI) programme.

Maths

We will secure our knowledge of numbers within 50. This will include partitioning tens and ones as well as estimating on a number line. We will also be working on finding 1 more and 1 less. We will then move on to length and height where we will compare, describe and solve problems. We will introduce vocabulary such as: 'longer, shorter, double and half'. Towards the end of the term, we will move on to mass and volume where we will use the terms heavier, lighter and equal to.

Science

We will begin to learn about seasonal changes and identify what happens during each of the four seasons. We will also learn some basic weather symbols.

Humanities (History/Geography)

Our history topic leads us to investigate the changing state of toys from a very long time ago until today. In geography, we will continue learning about the countries and capitals of the UK, including their famous landmarks



P.E

One lesson per week will be continuing to develop the children's throwing and catching skills. With our Aston Villa coach, the children will develop their gymnastic techniques.

Art and Design Technology (DT)

We will continue learning about line, shape and thickness as well as colour mixing. We will use different types of brush strokes and create concentric circles in the style of Kandinsky. In DT, we will be making healthy smoothies, safely preparing, washing and cutting fruit

Music

The children will focus on finding the pulse in a piece of music and clapping the rhythms. They will also learn about the pitch and have the chance to take part in a class performance incorporating rapping, singing and playing instruments.
