RE/PSHE

In RE, we will look to be reflective and curious within religious beliefs. In PSHE, we will look at stereotypes and families in the wider world.

Computing

In computing, we will learn about audio editing. Children will be able to make voice recordings and edit these before creating podcasts.

French

We will begin to give detail to our greetings by adding opinions to our vocabulary. We do this by expanding our French phonics.

Reading

In reading, we will be looking at a range of texts and focusing on fluency and comprehension skills.

Maths

This half term, children will be learning about multiplication and division. This is an essential key skill that children in Year 4 need due to the multiplication test in the summer term.

Writina

We will be looking at Tar Beach by Faith Ringgold where we will be writing our own playscripts and poetry. We will then look at The Iron Man by Ted Hughes where we will write letters, diary entries and short news bulleting.

Humanities (History/Geography)

In history, we will learn about Boudicca, a heroic warrior who fought against the Roman invasion.

We will also consider the Roman legacy in Britain. In geography, we will learn about Bologna, an important city in Italy.

Art and Design Technology (DT)
